1. Meeting was called to order at 3:25p.m.
2. Mark motioned to approve minutes of previous meeting. Minerva seconded the motion; motion carried.
 - a. New Site Council officers elected: Mark Wolfe as President, Austin Wilhite as Vice President and Alice Lark as Secretary
3. Shiloh School After School Program Review: With the absence of Justin, Mr. Ehrler stated that attendance in ASP is still high and there were no other known items to be addressed.
4. Shiloh School Safety Discussion/Review: Meeting members discussed the improved safety of the parking lot with the new addition of speed bumps and the presence of CHP. Mr. Ehrler mentioned That Ron Reed from the Sheriff's Department is monitoring local schools, and officer Leon (with CHP) is checking on drivers safety at Shiloh.
5. Budget Review-Categorical Programs: Mr. Ehrler reviewed the numbers with us with most remaining the same as before with the majority of spending going to salaries, some to PD and technology. Seth also shared the benefits of our newly adopted software, iready, using generic data, with council members.
6. School Campus Development Update: Mr. Ehrler stated that, although Proposition 55 and 51 passed, there is still 1.7 billion dollars of bonds waiting to be distributed. Currently, we are waiting to hear more on allocation of monies.
 - a. Mark asked Mr. Ehrler about the need for at least one new portable/permanent classroom for the following year. Mr. Ehrler responded that, although we do plan to get a classroom, we are waiting to see if renting or building a new classroom will hurt the amount we may receive for expansion funding. Accountants are considering the options.
7. Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) Update: Mr. Ehrler distributed the current LCAP report (still in progress) with a new template format for 2017-2020. Mr. Ehrler stated a summary would be available next week and Parent Surveys would be distributed and collected at Open House to further parent/student satisfaction.
8. Miscellaneous: No new items to discuss.
9. Mark Wolfe motioned to adjourn at 3:54pm, Mr. Ehrler seconded the motion; motion carried.

Miscellaneous: Minerva suggested doing a school-wide "Market-Day" (Entrepreneurial event) with students creating items to sell for "Ram Bucks" (school money) in order to motivate and inspire students' creativity. Mr. Ehrler requested she bring back more information (proposal) for Site Council to review.
